

NOTICE OF WATER RATE INCREASE

Date: November 16, 2018

Parker County Special Utility District Customers

The Parker County SUD Board of Directors met at a Regular Board Meeting on November 15, 2018 and approved an “Order Adopting Change in Water Rates for the District”. The District recently hired a firm to conduct a study of the cost of water service provided by the District to its customers and to recommend changes in water rates, if necessary.

The Board has reviewed the reports and recommendations from the firm and after review of the rate study, a 12 % Rate Increase from the City of Mineral Wells, the District’s budget, the District’s future water needs and supply, and such other matters the Board believes are relevant, the Board adopted an Order for a rate increase and will be **effective on the December/January billing period (bill will be due February 10, 2019).**

A Summary of the rate changes is set forth below:
