Re: Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) Monitoring, Routine (DBP), Major/Chlorine

The PARKER COUNTY SUD GROUND WATER system PWS ID 1840025 has violated the

monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title

30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to

properly disinfect water before disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution

system and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from

microbial contamination. This violation occurred in the monitoring period for the 4th Quarter

(October/November/December) 2022.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: Since the District shows that both forms for

the Surface and Ground Water were sent to TCEQ, the District needed a Certified Mailing Receipt to

prove it was mailed to have the violation removed. In the future, the District will mail each report

separately and send by certified mail.
