Stage I Water Conservation Update

Re: Changes to Once-a-Week Outdoor Watering Schedule. Stage I Water Rationing (may use irrigation) Once per Week According to Your Physical Address

PCSUD would like to thank all of our customers for their cooperation during last summer's drought and remind everyone that we are still currently under STAGE I WATER RATIONING. Many surrounding water companies are under more severe stages of water rationing since they are experiencing less precipitation in their watershed. PCSUD is trying to remain proactive and remind our customers of the drought conditions that we are expected to be facing very soon. If we receive cooperation from our customers to limit their outdoor watering to once a week then we may be able to avoid going to Stage II water rationing this year. Our reverse osmosis treatment plant will be fully operational by mid-summer, and we will be capable of making 2MGD (currently 1MGD). Also, our distribution plan will commence in the first quarter of next year, so we'll be able to move more of our own water into our system to reduce our reliance on outside sources of water.

Water conservation is key to staying into Stage I and not proceeding to Stage II; which is no outside water use except for livestock variances. Many times, we see outdoor watering occurring in the heat of the day and in direct sunlight. Please be a responsible steward of the water and use it wisely.

The changes the District is trying to implement to the once-a-week schedule are because during a system-wide audit of addresses, the district observed a large number of addresses ending in zeroes and ones. This caused a higher demand on the system during the first of the week and an inverse during the last part of the week. This made it extremely difficult for our employees to send water where it was required to meet the demand and to monitor for leaks within the system. To provide you with consistent service at the lowest cost, please refer to the new watering schedule the District has implemented.

Physical addresses ending in the following numbers may water with unattended irrigation/sprinklers on the days indicated. Example: Your time begins at midnight of your day to 10am then you may commence from 6pm to midnight:

0: Monday	1: Tuesday	2 and 3: Wednesday
4 and 5: Thursday	6 and 7: Friday	8 and 9: Saturday

In an effort to replenish our storage tanks, please note:
No outside watering may occur between the hours of 10AM and 6PM.
No outside watering may occur on Sunday.
